End of Year Expectations for Reading, Writing and Maths

FOUNDATION STAGE

Reading

- Can read and understand simple sentences
- Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately - red level
- Read some common irregular words
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read

Writing

- Use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds
- Write some irregular common words
- Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others
- Spell some words correctly with others being phonetically plausible

Maths

- Count reliably with numbers from 1-20
- Place the numbers 1-20 in order
- Say which number is one more or one less than any given number to 20
- Using quantities and objects, add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer
- Solve problems including doubling, halving and sharing
