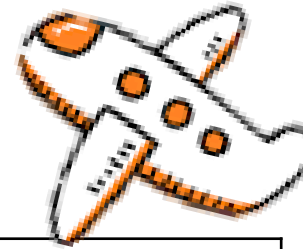


Our Wonderful World



Our texts will be:

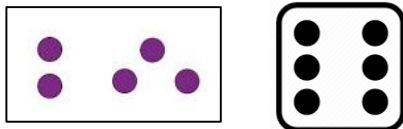


Our literacy learning will be:
